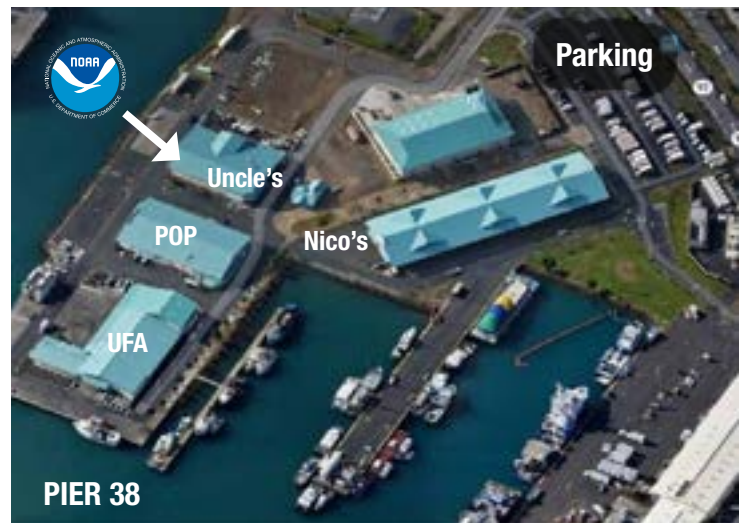
PURPOSE

This is your chance to share information and raise any concerns, issues and recommendations to improve non-commercial fisheries in Hawaii and throughout the Pacific Islands Region.

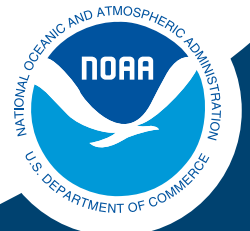
